## NCAA Announces UNH and Verizon Wireless Arena as Hosts of 2017 Men's Hockey Northeast Regional

**INDIANAPOLIS** – The NCAA Division I Men's Ice Hockey Committee announced that the University of New Hampshire in conjunction with the Verizon Wireless Arena in Manchester, N.H. will host the 2017 Division I Men's Ice Hockey Northeast Regional March 25-26.
